Kinder-6th Grade Classes

➤ Arts & Crafts

The goal is to help prepare your child to feel more confident in the kitchen and to learn new skills while learning how to properly use kitchen tools, read recipes, appliances, and food safety procedures. Appliances include, but are not limited to, hand mixer, blender, toaster oven, microwave, toaster, and hot plate. **SUPPLY LIST:** apron

➤ Intro to Spanish

➤ Theatre Arts

Do you love the performing arts? Then this class is for you! The Theatre Arts program will cover a variety of elements of the performing arts including dancing, acting, singing, production elements and so much more! This class will encourage students to become more confident while exploring their creativity.

➤ **Music & Dance**

Students will learn creative dance through Classical and Christian music selections from a real ballerina! Dance will include lyrical and ballet. There will be an introduction to flags/streamers and small instruments, too! 6th Grade and Up Classes

➤ **Chess Club**

Love chess? Join chess club to play, learn, teach, strategies, and spend time with friends. All chess equipment will be provided.

➤ **Math Club**

This club provides an opportunity for students to challenge themselves in mathematics. Students will experience fun and challenging math problems/games that promote critical thinking and problem-solving skills.

➤ **Advanced Art (students in 9th grade and up receive .5 credit, per semester, towards HS graduation requirements)**

Students will use a multitude of mediums to create advanced art pieces that will be cherished for years to come! Students will study and complete line drawing, doodle drawing, macrame, pixel art, deco art, abstract painting, air dry clay, paper mâché, landscape portraits, and more!

➤ **Computer Skills & Coding (students in 9th grade and up receive .5 credit, per semester, towards HS graduation requirements)**

Students will learn how to start typing using the home row keys and master timed keyboarding tests, including the 10-key number pad. They will explore the Microsoft Office software and learn how to create a spreadsheet, write a paper, make charts, create a Power Point presentation, safely use the internet, and receive an introduction to computer coding. These are all skills students will need for college and within their future career. **SUPPLY LIST:** headphones

➤ **Home Economics (students in 9th grade and up receive .5 credit, per semester, towards HS graduation requirements)**

Students will learn the basics of how to survive as an adult to include: hand-stitching, cooking, cleaning, money management, car maintenance, newborn baby care, selfcare, mental health care, and more!

➤ **Cooking & Kitchen Skills**

Students will enjoy practical teaching, fun activities, and kitchen labs while learning how to cook simple meals and snacks. The goal is to help prepare your child to feel more confident in the kitchen and to learn new skills while learning how to properly use kitchen tools, read recipes, appliances, and food safety procedures. Appliances include, but are not limited to, hand mixer, blender, toaster oven, microwave, toaster, and hot plate.

➤ **Choir (students in 9th grade and up receive .5 credit, per semester, towards HS graduation requirements)**

Interested in singing or improving your vocals? Students will explore vocal technique, choral singing tone, and performance techniques. They will have the opportunity to participate in Christmas and end-of-year recital.

➤ **Theatre Arts (students in 9th grade and up receive .5 credit, per semester, towards HS graduation requirements)**

The Theatre Arts program will cover a variety of elements of the performing arts including dancing, acting, singing, production elements and so much more! This class will encourage students to become more confident while exploring their creativity.

➤ **Snapology**

The robotics programs teach students the basics of computer programming and engineering through interactive robotic model builds and challenges. All activities embody S.T.E.A.M. (science, technology, engineering, art, math)! The activities challenge participants to cultivate problem solving skills through application of the scientific method and project planning.

➤ **Handmade Market**

In this class students will learn entrepreneurial skills by creating handmade goods, marketing their items, and selling their handmade creations. Projects will include handmade soaps, candles, jewelry, home décor, clothing, and anything else young entrepreneurs can think of! Students will host events throughout the year to market and sell their items to begin earning their own money. This class will be a perfect blend of creativity, money management, and marketing!

➤ **8th and Up: Chinese I (students will receive .5 credit, per semester, towards HS graduation requirements)**

This class will provide the student with a general introduction to the Chinese language: sound, pronunciation, vocabulary related to everyday life, cultural information, and basic grammatical structures. Emphasis will be on the acquisition of four skills: listening, speaking, reading and limited writing. The goal is to give the students the ability to carry on a simple conversation and to provide the students with instruction that teaches a basic understanding of Chinese culture, vocabulary, and grammatical concepts.

PREREQUISITE: none

➤ **8th and Up: Spanish I (students will receive .5 credit, per semester, towards HS graduation requirements)**

Emphasis will be on the acquisition of four skills: listening, speaking, reading and limited writing.
